The 29-year-old entrepreneur, who inherited the restaurant biz from her father when she was 22, combines both passions in Wellington's Equestrian Club by Tavern on the Green. "I love Wellington. It's where the biggest horse show in America is," she says, referring to the Winter Equestrian Festival, which runs through April 6. LeRoy, who co-owns the restaurant with Mark Bellissimo, has enlisted Tavern chef Frank Heizler to serve up favorites such as lobster bisque, Caesar salad and wild mushroom strudel. She has created an elegant setting, designed around crystal chandeliers from the Tavern and the Russian Tea Room, and her parents' Tiffany chandeliers. The outdoor dining area overlooks the Palm Beach International Equestrian Center show grounds – idyllic scenery for the horsey set.
